Attention, Everyone Please Read

It has come to our attention that American Airlines has made errors in Local 514's members insurance cards and coverage. We are advising you to take time and make sure you have received your insurance and Medco Pharmacy cards. Everyone should have received them the last part of December 2011. Temporary medical or Medco cards are available on Jetnet.

- 1) Please check to see if you have received your Insurance and Medco cards.
- 2) Ensure the names on the insurance card have been spelled correctly, and all the names of your family members are on the insurance card.

We also need you to go to the Benefit Service Center on the "My Benefits" page on Jetnet. You should make sure that you can see your 2012 benefits. These selections should reflect the selections you made in October of last year. Next, make sure your family members are covered by the green check marks next to their name. Also, please check your personal information on Jetnet to make sure it is correct.

Insurance Information Update

Due to a policy uploading issue with the enrollment firm, we were not able to start the deductions on the majority of the AFLAC Whole Life & Critical Illness policies. USI will send out invoices to these members requesting the premium for the month of January. All of these member's deductions will then start on February 1st, 2012.

In addition to the above issue, there maybe a few members who have encountered a deduction that has stopped or has not started. When the enrollment firm collected the policies, they did not collect SS numbers, only badge numbers. When USI obtained the file, we matched the file against badge numbers to try and obtain the SS# during the upload process. There have been a couple reported cases that the badge number obtained by the enrollment firm was incorrect causing a deduction issue. USI will react to these cases as they are brought to our attention. We will be able to catch the majority if not all of these cases after we receive the January remittance from American Airlines. With that being said, most of the badge numbers and deductions will not be updated until March 1st. The reason for this delay is that we have to send the February change file over to American Airlines by the end of January and the remittance file will not be received until the first week in February. USI will send missed deduction invoices to those employees who did not have a deduction.

Attention Transfers

If you are a transfer from another local and previously had Long Term Disability Deductions, you should check your pay stub to ensure LTD is being deducted. If not, then contact Mary Gorremans at 918 384-9483.
