Early Out Sign Up Procedure

- Go to Jetnet
- Across the top select **Policies and Procedures.**
- Over on the left side select **People Reduction Information.**
- At the middle of the page select **TWU Represented Employees.**
- There are several links on this screen with useful information.
- To sign up for the EO Option Select **Who's Offering?/ Election Form** (note: The Revocation Letter is below the Who's Offering Link).
- The heading in Blue lists the various offerings: select **"Online Election Form"** for the offer that applies to you.
- This screen has several old listings as well as the current offers.
- VEO means Voluntary Early Out, SIS means Stand In-Stead.

Do Not End Your Prefunding

Please DO NOT END your Prefunding contributions right now. If you end your contributions, then the court rules in the 1114 process that members are entitled to a company match, you will NOT be entitled to the company match. So it is very important to stay in the Prefunding program until it ends. When the Prefunding program ends, you will receive your refund within 120 days of the signing of the Agreement which was September 12, 2012.

American Airlines Relocation Policy for Domestic Non-Management Employees

Revised 5/23/12

We understand that relocating can be an overwhelming process and we want it as trouble free as possible. This packet contains critical information you will need before you plan your move. So please carefully review it and let us know right away if you have any questions.

If you are a current non-management employee you are eligible for the following:

- One (1) move package per household.
- Shipment of Household and Personal Goods by Atlantic Relocation Systems (ARS) the company authorized Relocation Company or reimbursement for a self move.
- Miscellaneous Move Allowance of \$600.00
- House hunting reimbursement
- En route Expenses
- Relocation from current work location only
- Qualified Life Event

The complete information on the relocation policy is on JetNet. Just click the icon “policies and procedures” on the top of the home page. Then go to the left side of the page in blue click the words “People Reduction Information”. Click the TWU representative employee icon. You should then look for the heading in red stating “More Information”. Click on the words “relocation policy” in blue.

Claim Purchase Opportunity

There are members being contacted by claim purchase companies offering to buy American Airlines debt such as the claim a member filed against AA. They are independent companies asking to settle your claim for a percentage amount. They could be actually settling for 100% of your claim but only giving members pennies on the dollar. We are recommending to our members to be very careful. Our attorneys agree this is a very complex issue and we cannot recommend to our members whether to settle their claim or not. As always, be careful if anyone is asking for account numbers, addresses, and social security numbers.
