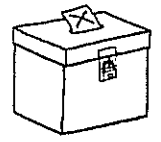

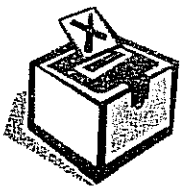

Jordan Sr. has raised \$25,500 through the Philip C. Jordan Jr. Memorial Golf Tournament in the last 4 years. Money raised through the

tournament has funded the PC Jordan Jr. Memorial Scholarship fund which has provided scholarships to 7 recipients of a \$1,000 each so far. In addition to the scholarships, money raised from the year's event was donated to the El Paso, TX. Chapter of the Epilepsy Foundation of West Texas (EFWT), to assist families of individuals with epilepsy and their families.

This year's tournament was on May 29, 88 golfers participated and Local 514 sponsored a hole and sponsored 2 teams to participate.

The golf tournament raised \$7,500 from the event this year.
