- (d) The Company will continue to assign American Airlines TWU represented employees in classifications, consistent with its established practices, as designated by the Company to all stations wherein such TWU represented employees are assigned currently with 1460 5475 and above annual departures and will staff new cities (those not currently staffed by the TWU) at or over 3650 9125 annual departures. The Company will also re-staff former TWU staffed cities with 1460 5475 and above annual departures.
 - (1) Notwithstanding the above, the Company will not be obligated to continue staffing any station except as provided by Article 42 (Job Security) wherein the scheduled annual departures at those stations fall below 1460 5475 departures.
 - (2) The determination of such scheduled departures will be made each January 1 and July 1 and will consider the prior twelve (12) month period.
 - (3) It is agreed that as other stations are established during the term of this Agreement, the Union will be notified prior to the opening, and conferences will be held between the parties regarding the staffing of these stations. The Company retains the right to staff stations at its discretion.
