Although I am fortunate and grateful that my immediate family in Haiti is well, the need is so great that I feel compelled to ask for help. So many were left homeless, and are forced to sleep in the street with no shelter from the elements.

My goal is to send small tents that can easily be moved. I hope that you will join me in this small effort to help these very desperate families in Haiti.
