When session started in February, the Oklahoma AFL-CIO was tracking almost 350 bills that would have affected our members. Through the work of many labor organizations, many bad legislative bills have already died. However; there are still bills out there that we are pushing to pass (which would help working Oklahomans), and others we are still trying to kill. These bills include; destroying teachers' pensions, changes to workers' compensation, attacks on dues deductions, and legislation that would require locals to have to re-sign every member every five years. 
At the collective bargaining table, in the community, in the exercise of the rights and responsibilities of citizenship, we shall responsibly serve the interest of all American People.
