### **General Membership Motion Submission Form.**

Change to Local 514 By-Laws - ARTICLE IV - Officers - item f. and g. as listed below.

f. In the event the President is unable, for any reason, to complete his term of office, the First Vice President shall automatically become President. The Second and Third Vice Presidents shall temporarily fulfill the duties of the First and Second Vice President in that order. In the event of a vacancy in any elected official other than President, the first qualified runner-up in the last regular election of the vacant position shall fill the vacancy.

g. All vacancies except the President that ran unopposed or the first qualified runner-up declines and all subsequent qualified runners-up decline filling the vacant position it shall be filled by a special election. Time and place will be determined by the Election Board.  
During the interim period required to hold a special election, the Executive Board may appoint a member in good standing who meets the qualifications under Article 8, Paragraph C, of these Bylaws, for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days before an election is called.

~~g. All vacancies except the President and the Executive Board Members at large shall be filled by a special election. Time and place will be determined by the Election Board. During the interim period required to hold a special election, the Executive Board may appoint a member in good standing who meets the qualifications under Article 8, Paragraph C, of these Bylaws, for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days before an election is called.~~
