

Important information about the 2022 ANNUAL FUNDING NOTICE (AFN) distribution

What's new: Starting April 21, we will be sending the 2022 Annual Funding Notices to all legacy American pension plan participants.

Why it matters: These notices provide information on the overall financial status of the plans and are required by the Pension Protection Act of 2006.

- Plan participants **do not need to take any action.**
- Depending on your role at American or if you opted in for electronic communication, you may receive your notice via email as early as Friday, April 21.
- Otherwise, notices will be mailed on Friday, April 28.

Q1: I do not know how to log into my NetBenefits account.

A1: If you are new to NetBenefits, you will first need to set up a password in order to access your account information or make transaction requests.

- From the NetBenefits' login screen, simply click Register Now. Follow the prompts to verify your identity and assign yourself a password.
- Or you can call the American Airlines Service Center at Fidelity at 800-354-3412 and follow the prompts to create your password.

Q2: How do I find my Annual Funding Notice on NetBenefits?

A2: Once logged into NetBenefits:

- Select Plan Information and Documents from the Quick Links menu.
- Your 2022 Annual Funding Notice is posted in the Other Documents section.

Q3: How do I review my accrued pension benefit on NetBenefits?

A3: Once logged into NetBenefits:

- Your accrued benefit will be displayed on the Pension Summary page, and can be accessed virtually, 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
- You may print a copy of this information by clicking on the Print This Page link in the upper right-hand corner of the screen.

Q4: How can I obtain information about my accrued pension benefit without internet access?

A4: Call the American Airlines Service Center at Fidelity at 800-354-3412, Monday through Friday (excluding all New York Stock Exchange holidays except Good Friday) between 8:30 a.m. and midnight ET, to obtain a free paper copy of your statement.
